Joyce Cheng, MPH, MS, Executive Director of the Chinese Community Health Resource Center, and Janice Tsoh, PhD, Professor Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at UCSF have received a 3-year Community Partnered Participatory Research Award from the Tobacco-Related Disease Research Program to for their grant proposal "Ending Tobacco Use and Smoke Exposure Among Asian American Communities." The project will focus on evaluating the timing of integrating thirdhand smoking education to smoking cessation intervention among Chinese Americans.

DR. LILIANA PHAN RECEIVES PILOT GRANT

Liliana Phan, PhD, MPH, MS received a pilot proposal grant that focuses on understanding e-cigarette use behaviors among Asian American young adults and co-developing public education with Asian American young adults to communicate the harms of e-cigarette use. This pilot proposal is funded by Jefferson Health's Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center (SKCC) through their American Cancer Society Institutional Research Grant. Our research team also includes Kuang-Yi Wen, Hee-Soon Juon, and Julia A. Barta from SKCC.
