Asian American Data: What's Next on May 1, 2025

The UCSF Asian American Research Center on Health (ARCH), in collaboration with the UCSF Office of Diversity and Outreach, hosted a webinar panel discussion as part of Asian American Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander (AANHPI) Heritage Month. The panel discussion moderated by ARCH Co-Director Jane Jih, MD, MPH, MAS included Russell Jeung, PhD (San Francisco State University), Thu Quach, PhD (Asian Health Services), Neil Ruiz, PhD (Pew Research Center) and Akil Vohra, JD (AAPI Data). The webinar discussed the status and future trajectories of Asian American health, data, and policy on a state and national level. Alejandra Rincon, PhD, Assistant Vice Chancellor and Chief of Staff, UCSF Office of Diversity and Outreach, provided opening remarks while Tung Nguyen, MD, Founding Director of ARCH, provided closing remarks. Introducing the ASPIRE Asian American Cohort Study on May 7, 2025

As part of the UCSF AANHPI Health and Wellness week, the principal investigators (and ARCH members) Scarlett Gomez, MPH, PhD, Iona Cheng, PhD and Salma Shariff-Marco, PhD kicked off and introduced the ASPIRE Cohort Study, a study that will follow 20,000+ Asian Americans nationwide over time to study multilevel drivers of cancer. This cohort study will identify the causes of cancer among Asian Americans and work with communities to better understand how to prevent cancer. The webinar provided information on the unique cancer burden across Asian American ethnic groups and how the ASPIRE Cohort Study aims to address this.
